

**PART- E MINUTES OF THE 34<sup>th</sup> MEETING OF STATE LEVEL EXPERT APPRAISAL COMMITTEE (SEAC), JHARKHAND HELD FROM 07<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER, 2015**

The 34<sup>th</sup> meeting of State Level Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC), Jharkhand was held from 07<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> September, 2015 under the Chairmanship of Sh. A.K. Saxena in the Conference Room at 170 C, Ashok Nagar, Ranchi. The following members were present:

Various projects which were received by SEIAA after the previous SEAC meeting held from 10<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2015 and forwarded to SEAC for their technical appraisal came up for discussions. Also those Projects which were appraised in SEAC's earlier meetings in which PP's were asked to provide additional informations / clarifications were also considered for examination / scrutiny where the Project proponents had submitted replies. Accordingly, the Project proponents were asked to make technical presentation for the appraisal of their project before the committee.

The following salient observations made during the Presentation (Project Wise) in brief deserve serious consideration.

**A. Projects recommended to SEIAA for consideration of grant of EC.**

**1. Proposal related to Stone Mine (Renewal Project)**


**I. Goradih Stone Mine of Md. Afroz Alam at Mouza- Goradih, Thana- Gandey, Dist.- Giridih, Jharkhand (1.01 Ha).**

**Consultant- M/S SABZ Care Management Services, Deoghar, RQP- Sri P.K. Sen**

This is a Stone Mining Project for having an area of 1.01 Ha [Khata No.- 19, Plot No.- 43 (P)]. The committee noted that as per Form I it is a proposal for renewal of mine lease for which PP is seeking EC. The lease was valid w.e.f. 10.03.2002 for a period of 10 years.. Considering the fact that it is B2 Category of Project - as per EIA Notification dated 14.09.2006 the environmental impact assessment as well as Public Consultation is not required. The committee felt that TOR is not required, nor any formal EIA/EMP is to be prepared in the instant case. These prescribed exemptions (Based on SEIAA guidelines and decision taken vide MOEF Notification dated 14.09.2006 and decision taken by SEIAA in its 31<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 27.05.2015 point no.-8 **"In SEIAA meeting, dated 24.09.2013 for renewal of cases, the distance of 50 meters from forest boundary is revisited.**

**This decision was reviewed in this meeting and SEIAA decided that in case of renewal of mining proposals EC will be granted on as is where it is basis but not in the Notified / Demarcated forest) are recommended by the Committee in the instant case.**

The project was reviewed with respect to proposed Mining Plan, Environmental protection measures proposed to be adopted, proposal for carrying out CSR activities for socio-economic



development, development of green belt, due consideration of occupational health, etc. In view of the size of the mine, production rate and the mineral mined and the assurance given by PP that he will give due consideration to environment by maintaining haul roads and water sprinkling on same, carrying out CSR activities for socio-economic development, development of green belt, due consideration of occupational health of persons engaged in mining. The committee felt that the operation of the mine will have not have any major impact on the surroundings. The indicated project cost is Rs 15.50 Lakhs and a provision of Rs 0.82 Lakhs will be kept for Environment management.
